

1. Based on the evidence presented, there is a probability that Plaintiff will prevail on the merits of its claims in this lawsuit.

2. Given the evidence, if this Temporary Restraining Order does not issue, Plaintiff will suffer imminent and irreparable injury should defendants continue violate state law and the continuing rules of the Bexar County Democratic Party. Defendants will not be allowed violate state law and the continuing rules of the Bexar County Democratic Party.

3. The Court finds Plaintiff has no adequate remedy at law because, Defendant will continue to violate state law and the continuing rules of the Bexar County Democratic Party.

II.
RESTRAINING ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant, MONICA ALCANTRA, INDIVIDUALLY AND AS BEXAR COUNTY DEMOCRATIC CHAIR, and their officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys, and all other Persons in active concert or participation with any of them, who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service or otherwise, whether acting directly or through any trust, corporation, subsidiary, division, or other device, or any of them, except as provided herein, as stipulated by the parties, or as directed by further order of the Court, are hereby restrained and enjoined from:

- a. Appointing precinct chairs in violation of the continuing rules of the Bexar County Democratic Party and those precinct chairs that were illegally appointed to replace precinct chairs that were removed by Defendant are to cease and desist any action as precinct chairs;
- b. violating state law in the removal of precinct chairs of the Bexar County Democratic Party;
- c. ordering or directing the removal of precinct chairs of the Bexar County Democratic Party in violation of state law;

- d. violating the State Party Rules of the Texas Democratic Party or the Continuing Rules of the Bexar County Democratic Party;
- e. ~~removing Secretary, Garrett Mormando, and he is to remain in his position as Secretary of the Bexar County Democratic Party and continue to exercise his statutory duties as per state law and the continuing rules of the Bexar County Democratic Party,~~ 10/11
- f. ~~Removing, recalling or suspending Treasurer, Stephanie Carrillo, and she is to remain in her position as Treasurer of the Bexar County Democratic Party and continue to exercise her statutory duties as per state law and the continuing rules of the Bexar County Democratic Party.~~ 10/11
- g. ~~interfering with the statutory duties of the Secretary or Treasurer of the Bexar County Democratic Party;~~ 10/11
- h. removing or threatening the Plaintiffs and other Precinct Chairs with removal, suspension, or recall in violation of State Law; and
- i. Calling a special meeting or regular meeting of the Bexar County Executive Committee until the proper precinct chairs are updated and included on the Texas Secretary of State website and the precinct chairs that were improperly appointed to fill these vacancies are removed., or until this Court holds a hearing to determine the status of the precinct chairs.

III.

This Temporary Restraining Order shall be filed forthwith in the Clerk's office and entered of record. The Court orders the Clerk to issue notice to Defendant, Monica Alcantara, Individually and as Bexar County Democratic Chair that the hearing for Temporary Injunction is set for April 19th, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. in the Bexar County Presiding Court location at 100 Dolorosa, Suite 1.09, 1st Floor, Bexar County Courthouse, San Antonio, Texas 78205. The purpose of the hearing shall be to determine whether this Temporary Restraining Order should become a Temporary Injunction pending a full trial on the merits and ultimately a permanent injunction. The Court set bond at \$ 500. Unless extended for good cause shown or terminated by a subsequent order of the Court, this Temporary Restraining Order expires at 11:59 10/11/19


